## Notes from the Secretary:

Garbage/Recycling Center Change

- The current garbage/recycling center in Crosslake will be closing its doors to the public as of May 31, 2020.
- If you do not currently have a sanitation service to your residence on the lake, the next closest location to drop off items is the Ideal Corners Transfer Station.
- Address: 33503 West Island Lake Drive, Pequot Lakes
  - Located South of County Road 16 at the end of West Island Lake Drive.
  - 2.5 miles east of Hwy 371 -OR- 5.5 miles west of Ideal Town Hall
- An annual permit is required to use the facility. Residents to pay \$10, non-residences to pay \$12. Users pay the permit fee and an additional charge for each item or load brought to the transfer station. Cash or check only, no credit cards.
- Hours are from 8am to 4pm. Days vary be season, no Holidays available.

Fish Fund Donation (Walleye Stocking)
