2022 Fish Stocking

This year is a walleye fish stocking year! We will be looking to fund both lakes with walleye fingerlings. If you donate, please make sure to designate which lake you would like to donate to, as the balances are kept separately. Donations are accepted year around via filling out the dues form. You can combine your dues and fish

stocking donation into one check if you wish.

Fish fund donation details:

- Our 2022 donation goal is \$5000 between the two lakes.
- Stocking is 100% funded by contributions.
- 72% of past donations were under \$20.
- Stocking targets are based on the size of the individual lake (based on the # of fish per acre in compliance with DNR rules).
- In 2020, there was approx. 130# stocked between both lakes (Based off individual lake indicated donations).

Also in 2020, The DNR granted permission to GOLA to stock perch every other year, opposite of walleye stocking. This was an agenda item voted on during July 2021 meeting, voting based on majority. Outcome was to not stock perch at this time. This subject can be revisited in an upcoming meeting if desired.

Notes from the Treasurer

Minimal budget changes occurred over the Winter this past year. Budget balances remain virtually the same as 2021. Updated balance amounts to be shared at the Memorial weekend meeting.

Loon Nesting Signs

The GOLA board has approved loon nesting signs to be placed on both lakes warning boaters to stay their distance. We do know there are currently two loon nests placed out on O'Brien each year.

We are looking to understand how many loon nests are placed out on Goodrich. With that, the board will also be seeking volunteers to place the loon nesting signs out near the nests this year.

Fiber Internet Connection
